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# DESIGNING AND EVALUATING AN INTEGRATED MODEL FOR TEACHER PREPARATION STRATEGIES AND DEVELOPING THEIR PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCIES IN LIGHT OF PROPHETIC TRADITIONS AND MODERN CONTEMPORARY TRENDS IN TRAINING IN THE STATE OF KUWAIT

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## ABSTRACT

*This study aimed to design and evaluate an integrated model for teacher preparation strategies and the development of their professional competencies in light of Prophetic values and modern training trends. It employed a descriptive approach, reviewing previous literature and distributing a questionnaire to a group of experts using the Delphi method. The study reached several conclusions, the most important of which was that Prophetic values play a vital role in improving the quality of education through their positive impact on academic outcomes, teacher competency development, and the fostering of a positive learning environment. The study recommended several measures, including: adopting the model proposed by the researcher for teacher preparation strategies and the development of their professional competencies in light of Prophetic traditions and contemporary training trends in the State of Kuwait; and recommending that educational institutions work to improve learning environments by providing sufficient resources, promoting a culture of cooperation and respect, and developing innovative teaching methods that encourage participation.*

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## INTRODUCTION

1. **Academic Knowledge:** Teachers must have extensive knowledge of the subject they teach. This includes understanding the scientific and pedagogical content, in addition to how to use curricula and educational resources effectively.
2. **Pedagogical Skills:** Pedagogical skills include the ability to design lessons, apply diverse teaching strategies, and effectively manage classrooms. Teachers must be able to use innovative teaching methods that encourage interaction and participation from students.
3. **Self-Development:** Self-development is considered an essential part of teacher preparation, as teachers are encouraged to

participate in continuous training programs and workshops, which help them improve their professional skills and stay updated with the latest educational trends.

4. **Social Interaction:** Teacher preparation also highlights the importance of building positive relationships with students, parents, and colleagues. This interaction enhances the learning environment and contributes to better supporting students.
5. **Ethical Values:** Teacher preparation must include promoting ethical values and Prophetic principles, which help in shaping teachers' identities and their role as educators who improve behaviors and values among students.

Teacher preparation is considered a comprehensive process that aims to equip them with the knowledge and skills necessary to achieve success in the field of education. By focusing on the academic, pedagogical, and self-development aspects, teachers can become leaders in the classrooms, which contributes to improving the quality of education and creates a positive learning environment. The importance of teacher preparation is not limited only to achieving academic goals, but extends to include promoting human and ethical values that are considered a foundation for building an educated and prosperous society.

#### B. Core Competencies Required for Teachers:

Core competencies for teachers are considered crucial elements in improving the quality of education and enhancing the effectiveness of the educational process. These competencies represent a set of skills and knowledge that teachers must possess to ensure the provision of effective education that is appropriate for students' needs. Among the core competencies considered necessary to achieve educational goals are<sup>12</sup>:

1. **Content Knowledge:** Teachers must have a deep understanding of the subject they teach. This competency includes understanding the basic concepts, facts, and theories related to the subject, which enables them to convey information clearly and effectively.
2. **Teaching Skills:** This competency includes the ability to design and implement educational lessons that suit the diverse needs of students. Teachers must be able to use varied teaching

strategies, such as active learning, cooperative learning, and continuous assessment to measure student progress.

3. **Classroom Management:** Classroom management skills are essential for ensuring a positive learning environment. Teachers must be able to organize activities, manage behaviors, and build positive relationships with students, which contributes to enhancing interaction and participation within the class.
4. **Effective Communication:** Communication is a fundamental skill that teachers must possess. They must be able to convey information clearly, listen to students' needs, and provide constructive feedback. Effective communication helps build trust and strengthen positive relationships.
5. **Continuous Professional Development:** Teachers must be committed to continuous professional development by participating in workshops, training courses, and researching the latest educational trends. This commitment helps improve their teaching practices and keeps them informed of changes in the field of education.
6. **Adaptability:** In a rapidly changing world, teachers must be able to adapt to new challenges and changes in curricula and teaching methods. This competency is essential for keeping pace with the diverse needs of students and changes in the learning environment.
7. **Promoting Ethical Values:** Teachers must promote human and ethical values in their classrooms, as their role as role models for students is vital. This competency helps build a learning environment that supports respect and cooperation among students.

The core competencies required for teachers are essential for achieving the success of the educational process. By possessing content knowledge, teaching skills, classroom management, effective communication, and commitment to continuous professional development, teachers can deliver effective education that meets the diverse needs of students. Promoting these competencies contributes to building teachers who are capable of achieving educational goals and contributing to the formation of a conscious and educated generation, which enhances the quality of education and contributes to the development of society in general.

### C. Strategies for Developing Teachers' Professional Competencies:

Strategies for developing teachers' professional competencies are considered essential elements that

contribute to improving the quality of education and enhancing teacher effectiveness. The modern era requires teachers who possess advanced skills and the ability to adapt to rapid changes in curricula and teaching methods. Therefore, developing teachers' professional competencies is an urgent necessity for achieving excellent educational outcomes. Effective strategies in this area include<sup>13</sup>:

1. **Continuous Training and Workshops:** Continuous training is vital for developing teachers' professional competencies. By organizing workshops and training courses, opportunities can be provided for teachers to learn new strategies, educational technology, and modern teaching methods. These activities help enhance their skills and update their knowledge of educational practices.
2. **Cooperative Learning:** Cooperative learning is considered one of the effective strategies for developing professional competencies by exchanging experiences and ideas with colleagues. Teachers can benefit from the experiences of others and develop their skills. Discussion sessions and working groups focused on specific topics related to education can be organized, which promotes continuous learning.
3. **Mentorship and Guidance:** Mentorship and guidance are considered essential elements in teacher development. Through the presence of experienced teachers who can offer support and advice, new or less-experienced teachers can improve their skills faster. This process can include direct observation, constructive criticism, and providing advice on how to enhance teaching practices.
4. **Using Technology:** Integrating technology into the teaching and training process is one of the modern strategies that promotes the development of professional competencies. By using educational platforms, digital learning resources, and e-learning tools, teachers can access multiple educational resources and develop their skills in areas such as distance learning.
5. **Self-Assessment and Review:** Self-assessment is an effective tool for developing professional competencies. By reviewing personal performance and identifying areas needing improvement, teachers can set personal development plans. This helps enhance self-awareness and enables them to take effective steps to improve their teaching practices.

7. **Implementing Action Research:** Teachers can develop their professional competencies by conducting action research in their teaching areas. By studying the effect of different teaching strategies on student learning, they can improve their practices and offer new evidence-based ideas.

Strategies for developing teachers' professional competencies are necessary to ensure the improvement of educational quality and teacher effectiveness. Through continuous training, cooperative learning, mentorship, and the use of technology, teachers can enhance their skills and knowledge. Commitment to developing professional competencies contributes to building teachers who are capable of meeting the diverse needs of students and facing future challenges in the field of education, which enhances the quality of education and contributes to the development of society in general.

#### IV. QUALITY OF EDUCATION:

##### A. Definition of Quality of Education:

The quality of education is considered one of the fundamental concepts that contributes to improving the outcomes of the educational process and achieving its desired goals. The concept of educational quality expresses the extent to which the educational system is capable of meeting the needs of students and society, and ensuring an effective learning environment that promotes learning and personal growth. Therefore, understanding the quality of education is vital for developing curricula and teaching strategies. Educational quality is also defined as a set of standards and components that express the effectiveness of the educational system in achieving educational objectives. This quality includes several aspects, including<sup>14</sup>:

1. **Curriculum Content:** Academic content is considered one of the main components of educational quality. Curricula must be designed in a way that is appropriate for students' needs

and the requirements of the job market. Curricula should also reflect the values and knowledge necessary for developing students' skills.

2. **Teaching Methods:** The teaching methods used in classrooms are considered basic factors that affect the quality of education. Teaching strategies should be diverse and flexible, suitable for the different learning styles of students.
3. **Learning Environment:** Educational quality also refers to the learning environment in which students receive their education. This environment must be safe, encouraging, and supportive, which enhances students' motivation for learning and participation.
4. **Teacher Competency:** Teachers are considered one of the main factors affecting the quality of education. Teachers must possess sufficient knowledge and the necessary skills to deliver effective education. They should also be well-trained and participate in continuous professional development.
5. **Learning Outcomes:** Learning outcomes and educational outputs are considered indicators of educational quality. These results must show the extent to which students have achieved the targeted knowledge and skills, and how they apply them in practical life.
6. **Assessment and Review:** Assessment and review processes are important elements for ensuring the quality of education. There must be effective mechanisms for evaluating educational performance and providing the necessary feedback to improve performance.

##### B. Global and Local Standards for Educational Quality:

Global and local standards for educational quality are considered vital tools used to evaluate the effectiveness of educational systems and their ability to achieve their goals. These standards vary to include a set of elements that reflect the quality of education and help measure the performance of educational institutions, including<sup>15</sup>:

##### 1. Global Standards for Educational Quality:

- **Academic Accreditation:** Academic accreditation is considered an international standard that shows that an educational institution meets

specific quality criteria. Accreditation bodies evaluate the extent to which educational programs comply with global standards.

- **UNESCO Standards:** The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) has established a set of global standards for educational quality, including access to education, equity, and lifelong learning. These standards aim to promote education worldwide.
- **OECD Standards:** The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) provides international assessments such as the Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA), which measures students' skills in reading, mathematics, and science. The results of these assessments are used as standards to evaluate the quality of education in different countries.

## 2. Local Standards for Educational Quality:

- **National Education Policies:** Countries adopt local education policies that define the required standards for educational quality. These policies include curriculum objectives, educational benchmarks, and assessment methods.
- **National Assessment:** Many countries conduct periodic national assessments to measure student performance in various subjects. These assessments are considered a tool for identifying the strengths and weaknesses in the educational system.
- **Local Quality Standards:** Some countries adopt specific quality standards related to teacher competency, the learning environment, and educational strategies. These standards may include guidance for improving educational performance and developing academic programs.

## 5. Teachers' Professional Training:

### A. The Effectiveness of Training Based on Prophetic Values:

Training based on Prophetic values is considered one of the effective methods for enhancing teachers' professional competencies. By integrating Prophetic values into training programs, positive results that affect the quality of education and students' behavior can be achieved, through<sup>16</sup>:

#### 1. Promoting Ethical Values:

Training based on Prophetic values helps promote ethics and positive behaviors among teachers by teaching them the importance of values such as

truthfulness, sincerity, and justice. Teachers can become good role models for their students, which contributes to creating a learning environment that stimulates cooperation and respect.

#### 2. Stimulating Belonging and Loyalty:

Training based on Prophetic values enhances teachers' sense of belonging and loyalty to the educational institution. When teachers feel that Prophetic values form part of the institution's culture, they are more committed to providing high-quality education and achieving the educational institution's goals.

#### 3. Developing Communication Skills:

Training based on Prophetic values contributes to improving communication skills between teachers and students by promoting values of respect and understanding. Teachers can build positive relationships with their students, which leads to improved interaction and participation in the educational process.

#### 4. Fostering Self-Directed Learning:

Training based on Prophetic values encourages teachers to continuously develop their skills by reinforcing the value of lifelong learning. Teachers can strive to improve their competencies, which contributes to raising the standard of education.

#### 5. Developing Leadership Skills:

Training based on Prophetic values enhances teachers' leadership skills by teaching them how to take responsibility and positively lead classrooms. Teachers can become influential leaders in their educational environments.

#### 6. Improving the Learning Environment:

Focusing on Prophetic values contributes to creating a positive learning environment. When teachers adopt Prophetic values, they help build a school culture that supports cooperation and mutual respect, which leads to improving the quality of teaching and learning.

#### 7. Long-Term Impact on Students:

Training based on Prophetic values can have a long-term impact on students' behavior and performance. When teachers adopt these values, they contribute to shaping students' personalities and promoting their ethical values, which contributes to preparing a conscious and educated generation.

The effectiveness of training based on Prophetic values demonstrates the importance of integrating these values into teacher training programs by promoting ethics, stimulating belonging, and developing communication skills. This type of training can contribute to improving the quality of education and creating a positive learning environment. Investing in training based on Prophetic values is considered a strategic step toward achieving comprehensive education that promotes human values and contributes to the development of society in general.

### **Second: The Proposed Model of the Study (Prepared by the Researcher):**

This proposed model seeks to enhance teachers' competencies in general education schools in the State of Kuwait by establishing a comprehensive framework based on the Prophet's traditions (Hadith) and modern training trends. The model aims to integrate Prophetic values such as sincerity, justice, and proficiency with modern educational strategies, thereby enhancing the quality of the educational process and achieving positive results for students, through the following:

#### **1. Objectives of the Proposed Model:**

- a. Improving the Quality of Education:** The model seeks to enhance the quality of education by developing teachers' competencies using educational strategies based on the Prophet's traditions, which reflects the importance of sincerity (Ikhlas) in educational work and supports the improvement of students' academic outcomes.
- b. Developing Professional Competencies:** The model aims to enhance teachers' professional competencies, including justice and proficiency (Iqtan), leading to improved educational performance and a balanced learning environment. This is reinforced through the application of educational technologies such as Project-Based Learning (PBL) and Reflective Practice.
- c. Providing a Positive Learning Environment:** The model focuses on achieving justice among students and promoting the values of sincerity and proficiency as core values in the educational process, which contributes to creating an atmosphere of mutual trust and respect, and enhances the provision of psychological and social support for students.

#### **2. Content of the Model:**

- a. Developing Training Programs:** Designing comprehensive training programs that integrate modern trends in training, such as the TPACK model, which focuses on integrating technological, pedagogical, and content knowledge in education. Differentiated Instruction strategies can also be used to meet the needs of all students.
- b. Integrating Prophetic Values:** Explicitly integrating Prophetic values into all aspects of teaching and training, which helps teachers develop teaching practices centered on sincerity (as mentioned in the Hadith: "*Deeds are only by intentions*"), justice (as in the Hadith: "*Indeed, the most just of people in the sight of Allah on the Day of Resurrection.....*"), and proficiency (as in the Hadith: "*Indeed, Allah loves that when one of you does a job, he perfects it*"), thereby enhancing the effectiveness of education.

#### **3. Methods for Implementing the Model:**

- a. Teacher Training:** Organizing specialized training courses that focus on applying Prophetic values in education, including interactive workshops and seminars to enhance teachers' reflective thinking. This includes techniques such as Peer Coaching, which promotes the exchange of knowledge and experiences, while integrating Prophetic values within every step.
- b. Performance Evaluation:** Using objective evaluation tools such as questionnaires and classroom observations to measure the extent to which teachers apply Prophetic values in their teaching practices, which helps achieve fairness in evaluation and provide constructive feedback.
- c. Feedback:** Providing immediate feedback to teachers regarding their performance, which helps improve teaching practices and fosters continuous learning. Techniques such as Peer Assessment can be used to provide multiple insights into teachers' performance.

#### **4. Ways to Develop the Model:**

- a. Continuous Analysis:** Conducting periodic analyses of teacher performance and providing comprehensive reports to improve training programs based on the analysis results, which reflects the importance of proficiency and continuous development. Both quantitative and qualitative analysis methods can be used to understand the effectiveness of the training.
- b. Content Updating:** Reviewing and updating training materials periodically to ensure their

alignment with modern trends and educational needs. This includes integrating advanced technological content to meet the needs of the digital generation.

- c. Fostering Cooperation:** Encouraging teachers to exchange experiences and best teaching practices by establishing Professional Learning Communities, which promotes the spirit of cooperation and justice.

The researcher has previously collected the opinions of a group of experts in this field and subsequently analyzed them statistically to arrive at the final proposed model.

### Third: Study Methodology and Tools:

The current study is an important step toward understanding the impact of Prophetic values on the quality of education in the State of Kuwait, by analyzing teacher preparation strategies and the development of their professional competencies. This study relied on both the descriptive approach and the Delphi method, which allowed for a comprehensive and reliable analysis of the effect of Prophetic values on the quality of education and teacher competencies. The descriptive approach focused on collecting data from previous literature and relevant studies, which helped in understanding the historical and theoretical context of the studied topic and revealing current trends and challenges facing education. Meanwhile, the Delphi method was used to gather the opinions of a group of experts in the field of education across multiple rounds of questionnaires, which will enrich the study's results with diverse experiences and expertise. Through this integration of the two methods, the study seeks to provide deep insights into how to promote Prophetic values in education and their impact on the quality of the educational process, contributing to the development of effective strategies for teacher preparation and skill development. Through this comprehensive approach, the researcher hopes to provide evidence-based recommendations to support educational policies in Kuwait.

Data was analyzed using the SPSS software, where the statistical methods included Analysis of Variance (ANOVA) to analyze the differences among academic results based on Prophetic values, and

Multiple Regression Analysis to examine the effect of training programs on teacher competencies. Correlation analysis was also used to examine the relationship between the learning environment and mutual trust and respect.

A sample consisting of 33 experts in the field of education was selected, representing a variety of backgrounds and experiences. This sample included school principals, educational supervisors, and academics with extensive experience in education. Participants were chosen according to specific criteria, as each one is considered a trusted reference in their field, which enhances the credibility of the analysis. This sample is characterized by representing a focused group of individuals who can provide deep insights into how Prophetic values influence the quality of the educational process. Through the use of the Delphi methodology, multiple rounds of questionnaires were conducted, where the opinions of the sample members were sought regarding various aspects of education, which helped reach consensus on the main topics.

To ensure the accuracy and reliability of the results, multiple methods were applied to evaluate the reliability and validity of the scales used. Exploratory Factor Analysis was used to examine the extent to which the scales align with the adopted theoretical structure. This analysis allows for determining the ability of the tools used to effectively measure the targeted aspects. Reliability was assessed using the Cronbach's Alpha method, and the results showed a high value exceeding 0.85, which indicates a high level of internal consistency, meaning that the tool used was consistent in measuring opinions and attitudes among the participants.

### Fourth: Results of Testing the Study's Hypotheses:

#### 1. Results of Testing the First Hypothesis:

Hypothesis: "The teacher preparation model can enhance the quality of education by focusing on Prophetic values such as sincerity, justice, and role-modeling, which leads to improved academic outcomes for students."

To test the validity of the hypothesis, Analysis of Variance (ANOVA) was performed to examine the differences among academic outcome groups based on the levels of application of Prophetic values, as shown in Table (1):

It is clear from the previous table that the probability value ( $p = 0.008$ ) indicates the existence of statistically significant differences between the levels of application of Prophetic values and academic outcomes, which demonstrates their positive impact. The researcher attributes this effect to the fact that Prophetic values promote commitment and discipline among students, which is reflected in their academic achievement.

**2. Results of Testing the Second Hypothesis:**

Hypothesis: "Training programs based on the Prophet's traditions contribute to developing teachers' professional competencies, which positively reflects on teaching and learning methods."

To test the validity of the hypothesis, Multiple Regression Analysis was performed to examine the effect of training programs on teachers' competencies, as shown in Table (2):

It is clear from the previous table that all independent variables have a statistically significant effect on teachers' competencies, as the probability value ( $p < 0.05$ ) indicates the importance of the training programs in developing these competencies. The researcher attributes this to the fact that training programs based on Prophetic values enhance teachers' ability to deal with educational challenges effectively.

**3. Results of Testing the Third Hypothesis:**

Hypothesis: "The proposed model provides a positive educational environment, which contributes to creating an atmosphere of mutual trust and respect among students."

To test the validity of the hypothesis, Pearson Correlation Analysis was performed to examine the relationship between the positive educational environment and the levels of trust and respect, as shown in Table (3):

It is clear from the previous table that the associated values indicate a strong and positive relationship between the educational environment and trust and respect, as all probability values ( $p < 0.01$ ) indicate statistical significance. The researcher attributes this to the fact that a positive educational environment strengthens the relationships between students and teachers, which contributes to improving the learning experience.

**V. STUDY RESULTS AND DISCUSSION**

1. Statistically significant differences were found between the levels of application of Prophetic values and academic outcomes, where the probability value ( $p = 0.008$ ) indicated that Prophetic values have a noticeable positive impact on student achievement. This reflects that promoting Prophetic values such as sincerity and justice in the educational environment contributes to improving students' academic performance.

2. It was shown that training programs based on Prophetic values have a significant positive impact on teachers' competencies, as all variables were statistically significant ( $p < 0.05$ ). This indicates that training programs supported by Prophetic values enhance teachers' ability to achieve better results in the classrooms, which helps them face educational challenges more effectively.

3. A strong and positive relationship exists between the positive educational environment and levels of mutual trust and respect. This reflects that the presence of a learning environment that supports Prophetic values contributes significantly to fostering positive relationships between students and teachers, leading to an improved learning experience.

4. Responses from participants in the questionnaires showed significant support for the proposed model, which integrates Prophetic values into teacher preparation strategies and the development of their professional competencies. The model includes the following key points:

- a. **Promoting Prophetic Values:** By integrating values such as sincerity, justice, and proficiency into the educational process.
- b. **Developing Comprehensive Training Programs:** By providing training programs that support Prophetic values and enhance teachers' competencies.
- c. **Creating a Positive Learning Environment:** By focusing on building a learning environment that promotes mutual trust and respect between students and teachers.

Ninety percent of the participants offered positive feedback regarding the effectiveness of this model in improving the quality of education. This reflects a consensus among experts on the importance of integrating Prophetic values, which contributes to enhancing teacher competency and creating a positive learning environment that improves students' learning experience.

## VI. STUDY RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Adopt the proposed model prepared by the researcher concerning teacher preparation strategies and the development of their professional competencies in light of Prophetic traditions and contemporary modern training

- trends in the State of Kuwait.
2. Educational institutions should work to improve learning environments by providing adequate resources, fostering a culture of cooperation and respect, and developing innovative teaching methods that encourage participation.
3. It is recommended to integrate Prophetic values into teacher preparation and training programs, as this contributes to strengthening teachers' ethics and improving the quality of education.
4. Periodic training programs for teachers should be developed, focusing on enhancing their teaching and classroom management skills, which improves their performance and contributes to raising students' academic achievement.
5. It is advised to develop educational activities that enhance interaction between students and teachers, such as cooperative activities and group projects, which help build positive relationships and improve academic achievement.
6. Regular evaluation mechanisms should be implemented to monitor students' academic performance and teachers' performance, helping to identify areas for improvement and guide efforts toward achieving better outcomes.

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
